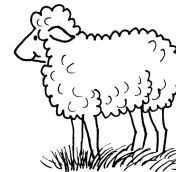
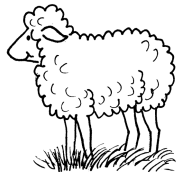


Kent and Lori Herbel

In 2002 Kent was the trainer and handler of the herding High in Trial dog at the Australian Cattle Dog Nationals, the Border Collie Nationals, the German Shepherd Nationals, and in the past has also won top honors at the Briard Nationals. He has trained and trialed successfully in AKC to the Herding Championship level as well as having trained successful Open level dogs in the USBCHA. Lori has trained and trialed to the Herding Championship level as well and was the trainer/handler of High in Trial at the 2001 BCSA National Specialty. Both Kent and Lori compete successfully in the arena as well as the open field. They also host both AKC and USBCHA trials each year at their ranch. Kent is well known for his ability to read and understand dogs and handlers as well as livestock, and is a great communicator as well as educator. He has worked with, and has an appreciation for, all of the herding breeds.

This clinic offers the unique opportunity to work on your handling for competitive herding, both in the arena and in the open field. Our facility offers a 15 acre field with the Course B obstacles as well as a 240 by 140 arena. This clinic is limited to twelve handler/dog teams with each dog being worked twice per day, so you will have ample time to sort out your problems. The cost of this clinic is \$325, with a \$100 non-refundable deposit to hold your spot. Auditing is available for \$125 for all three days or one day for \$50. A continental breakfast and lunch will be provided each day. All breeds are welcome. Don't miss this exciting herding opportunity! AKC trials on the same site the weekend before!
