2 Class Eligibility: Novice A Classes are open to dogs that have not completed any title for that particular element, that have not completed a comparable title with another organization, and whose handlers are neither Scent Work judges, nor have ever worked as professional detection dog handlers.
Novice B Classes are open to all have

Novice B Classes are open to all dogs.

Advanced Classes are open to dogs that have achieved the Novice title for that particular element. Excellent Classes are open to dogs that have achieved the Advanced title for that particular element. Master Classes are open to dogs that have achieved the Excellent title for that particular element.

- 3. Container Classes will be held indoors on a matted floor. Master and other Interior searches may take place in various buildings at the trial site with a variety of floor surfaces including packed dirt or concrete. Buried Classes may be outside on grass or inside the agility building on a hard-packed dirt floor. Exterior Classes may include steps within the search area; or uneven surfaces or steps to reach a search area. All Exterior Classes will be held outdoors rain or shine unless dangerous conditions are present (such as lightning). Comfortable footwear and water-resistant clothing are recommended. Exhibitors may need an extra pair of shoes for showing outdoors or on dirt. Please check the weather forecast before coming to the event.
- 4. The Detective Class offers an integrated search environment with an unknown number of hides in a variety of elements. The intent of the Detective Class is to emulate as closely as possible the work of a true detection dog. While the exact search areas for these trials are subject to change the planned search areas at Sunshine Obedience School, may include a kitchen, outdoor seating/patio area, walkway, basement, and backyard. Detective exhibitors will be directed where to park to alleviate line-of-site issues.
- 5. Dogs that have previously earned the same or higher level AKC Scent Work titles may enter lower level classes.
- 6. Dogs are eligible to enter up to two difficulty levels in each element, in each trial. Dogs may only enter a class once in each event. A class is defined as a particular difficulty level within a particular element.
- 7. Handlers may not handle more than one dog in each class (with the exception of Handler Discrimination classes). Multiple dogs from the same owner may be entered in the same class, provided they are run by different handlers.
- 8. Bellevue Dog Obedience Club will send its own specific guidelines for this event when we send the judging program after the event closes.

• ENTRY INFORMATION: FEES, DATES, and TIMES

Entries open Wednesday, September 20, 2023, at 9:00 AM CDT Entries accepted on a <u>first received basis</u> by USPS mail, FEDEX, or UPS <u>no earlier than</u> the above date and time.

- 1. Entry Fees
 - \$20 per each entry of each dog per regular trial. (Includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)
 - \$45 per each entry of each dog per Detective class. (Includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)
 - Dogs may be entered in no more than two (2) difficulty levels in each element in each trial.
- 2. Entry Closing Date: Entries will be accepted until Tuesday, October 31, 2023, at 6:00 PM CDT NO Entries will be accepted or processed after that time. NO EXCEPTIONS.

3. NO Day-of-Show Entries.

- 4. Each dog must be entered on a separate official AKC Scent Work entry form. (see attachment)
- 5. No telephone, e-mail, or fax entries will be accepted.
- 6. Any entry missing crucial information will not be processed, nor counted as received, until authorization is obtained.
- 7. Substitution Policy: There will be no substitutions. An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

• SUBMITTING ENTRIES

- 1. Entries must be submitted on an Official AKC Scent Work Entry form included with this Premium List. Photocopies of this form may also be used.
- 2. **Mailed Entries** must include all fees. Any mailed entries received without all fees will not be processed until such fees have been paid.

• PAYMENT FOR ENTRIES

- 1. Entry payment must be made by check or money order. No entry will be processed without full payment.
- 2. Make checks payable to Bellevue Dog Obedience Club (BDOC). Checks must be payable in U.S. funds.
- 3. Post-dated checks or returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. BDOC will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check or money order.
- 4. Checks will be held until the closing date.

• ENTRY CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS, & WAIT LIST

- 1. Entry cancellations MUST be received in writing (includes e-mail) prior to the closing of Entries and MUST include the dog's breed, AKC number, and name. Checks will be shredded. Cancellations received by telephone are NOT acceptable.
- 2. No refunds will be given for invalid entries and dogs entered in the incorrect class after the event is over.
- 3. Cancelled entries submitted before the close of the event's Pre-entry deadline will be charged a \$10 processing fee, if BDOC has to issue a refund check.
- 4. No entries will be refunded after the event is closed unless your entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry. (see #10)
- 5. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- 6. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- 7. Entry overpayments will not be refunded. Exhibitors may write a new check.
- 8. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 9. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snowstorms, tornadoes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.
- 10. A wait list with a maximum of twenty (20) entries will be established on a first received basis. All entries on the wait list must be received by the closing date. On the day of the trial, the club may assign entries for absent individuals to those on the wait list who are present at the trial site. If multiple waitlisted individuals are present at the event site, the runs will be assigned in waitlist order. A full refund will be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry.

• ENTRY CONFIRMATION, ARMBAND NUMBERS, AND JUDGING PROGRAM

- 1. **E-mailed confirmation of entries** will be sent to the e-mail address included on the entry form (please type or print clearly) as soon as possible after the entry has been accepted and processed. Please verify the classes your dog is entered into when receiving this e-mail of processed entry. Should there be any errors, please contact the Trial Secretary, Norine Nieman, at papnose@cox.net immediately.
- 2. One armband number will be assigned to each dog for all trials in which the dog is entered, and will be used to determine the running order of dogs as well as to help judges and trial officials identify dogs in their records. Numbers will be available at the secretary's table on each day of the trial.
- 3. The armband number need not be physically displayed on the dog or handler.
- 4. You will receive updated trial information after the trial closes.

CLASS TRANSFER/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

- 1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information and any errors on the entry forms. There will be no refunds for invalid entries. A **move-up transfer** may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is made. A **move-down transfer** may be requested if the owner mistakenly entered the dog in a higher-level class for which it is not eligible. A **lateral transfer** (from section A to section B in Novice) may be requested if the owner mistakenly entered the dog in section A, and it is not eligible. The request for a class transfer must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 2. Transfers may be approved provided the class is available and entry limits have not been met.
- 3. Dogs may also be **transferred** between trials. In the case of concurrent trials, the time limit is waived.

• EVENT HOURS: Event hours are: Friday - Saturday: 8:00 AM - 7:00 PM CDT and Sunday: 8:00 AM - 7:00 PM CST. Please note the time change for this weekend.

• GENERAL BUILDING, CRATING, PARKING, & FOOD INFORMATION

- 1. All event location times are Central Daylight Time for Friday & Saturday; and Central Standard Time for Sunday. Please Note: Clocks change this weekend.
- 2. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING on the property of the Sunshine Obedience School including in your vehicle.
- 3. Parking is on the concrete or in the designated area on the SOUTH(to your left as you drive in) side of the driveway.
- 4. For this event exhibitors are required to crate in or near their cars.
- 5. No food will be available for purchase at this event. Please bring your own food and drink.

• TRIAL TIMES:

- 1. On Friday Sunday there will be a judges' briefing at 8:30 AM followed by the classes. Trial start time is the same for each day. **Remember to change your clocks on Saturday night!!**
- 2. Class order will be determined after the trial closes. Exhibitors will receive trial information with class order and a complete judging program after closing.
- 3. There will be a lunch break each day at the judges' discretion.

EXHIBITOR AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. All events are held under the revised Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club, Inc. effective on October 1, 2019. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the event in which they have entered. Here is the link to the <u>AKC Scent Work Rules</u>.
- 2. BDOC, its agents; AKC, its agents and its employees; assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, ILLNESS, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. AKC and BDOC are not responsible for any loss, accidents, or theft.
- 3. The owner or designated handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The host organization, event committee, and Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system, or stewards or runners for the purpose of locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- 4. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may leave the trial site.
- 5. No unentered dogs allowed on the event grounds. Note: no dogs less than 8 weeks of age may be present on the grounds of an AKC licensed event.
- 6. Dogs are not to be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or un-zippered crate.
- 7. Except when being crated or exhibited, dogs must be kept on leash.
- 8. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Please potty your dog on the SOUTH side of the driveway and use the provided receptacles for disposal. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
- 9. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of an AKC licensed event.
- 10. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. BDOC cannot make special accommodations for certain dogs, such as dogs determined by their owners to be "reactive." AKC will vigorously support any facility that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, AKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
- 11. Females in season will not be allowed to compete. A refund minus \$5 processing fee will be given if your female is withdrawn no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial.



- 12. Trial Site: It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.
- 13. Possession of Odors and Training. No person other than those engaged in the administration of the trial shall be in possession of any of the target odors when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than in the designated warm-up area.
- 14. Spectator Area: Spectators will be allowed for the outdoor elements for this event. Exhibitors may have one person videotape them during their runs. Please do not share videos with others in your class.
